A MESSAGE FROM FATHER SLAWEK

Praise be Jesus Christ... Now and Forever.

I thought many of you would like to see the fruit of your generosity this Advent season. Again, this year the family of Mary Queen of Heaven rose to the occasion and shared with others less fortunate. Over 30 families were helped by your generosity. Additional families were helped by parishioners wishing to remain anonymous who wanted to contribute even more. As a family and church, I am sure it warms your hearts, as it does mine, to know how well we take care of those in need. Thank you, from the bottom of my heart, for hearing the "cry of the poor," with your overwhelming response to their needs. I would like to thank Sheila Reiter and her team for coordinating the giving tree and for all of her hard work to segregate all of the gifts for the individual families.

Advent is not about the gifts we receive, but rather it is about who we are and the changes we make. Through the generosity we share with others and the changes we make in ourselves; we manifest Christ in the world. This helps us during this time of preparation to receive the newborn Jesus anew at Christmas.

The Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete Sunday, is a time of joy and anticipation as we near the celebration of Christ's birth. In the Gospel of Luke 3:10-18, John the Baptist provides practical guidance to those preparing for the coming of the Messiah. The crowd, recognizing their need for repentance, asks, "What then shall we do?" John's response is simple yet profound: share with those in need, act justly, and live a life of integrity. This message reminds us that true repentance is not merely about words but a transformation of our daily actions to reflect God's love and justice.

John's responses to the tax collectors and soldiers highlight the universal call to holiness within one's vocation. He doesn't ask them to abandon their professions but to practice them ethically and without greed or abuse. This teaches us that no matter our state of life, we are called to live out our faith in concrete ways. Advent challenges us to examine our relationships and responsibilities, ensuring that our actions align with God's will. By doing so, we prepare our hearts not only for the celebration of Christ's birth but for His ongoing presence in our lives.

The Gospel concludes with John proclaiming the coming of one "mightier than I," who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. This anticipates the transformative power of Christ, who purifies and renews us. Gaudete Sunday invites us to rejoice in this promise of salvation and to embrace the joy that comes from living a life oriented toward God. As we light the rose candle, we are reminded that amidst the penitential spirit of Advent, there is a deep and abiding joy in knowing that the Lord is near.
